FIELD KIT LOGISTICS

Plain answer

The program is not one product. It is a set of practical access paths that can be combined based on the field need.

Field steps

01

Assess the setting

Document language, device types, power, internet reality, and whether use is individual or group-based.

02

Pick the access path

Choose phone transfer, microSD, USB, Raspberry Pi library, projector, power, or satellite receive-and-replay.

03

Prepare the kit

Load content, label cables, charge batteries, and pack the matching printed guides.

04

Train the local user

Teach the person who will repeat the setup after the visiting team leaves.

05

Improve from feedback

Use partner reports to improve content, equipment, and training before scaling.

FIELD PROMISE

Start with the least complicated path that serves the ministry need.

01

Phone distribution

Move resources from one device to another without mobile data.

02

VillageServer kit

Create a local Wi-Fi library with a Raspberry Pi.

03

Power and media

Support teaching with solar, batteries, projectors, and audio.

04

Satellite reception

Receive Free-to-Air Christian broadcasts where appropriate.
