Plain answer

Use Quick Share when available, or LocalSend when both Android phones can join the same network.

Field steps

1. Turn on Quick Share - Open sharing settings and allow nearby sharing temporarily.
2. Choose the file - Open Files or Downloads and select one resource first.
3. Send nearby - Tap Share, choose Quick Share, and select the receiving Android phone.
4. Accept and open - Accept on the receiving phone and open the file from Downloads or Files.
5. Repeat once - Have the receiver send the same file to a second phone.

Key points

Best use: Use this handout when this exact device route is in front of you.

First test: Move one small file before moving a whole folder.

Offline check: Confirm the received file opens without mobile data.

Teach-back: Ask the receiving person to repeat the transfer.
