



# Computer to Phone Transfer

Use a cable, Finder, Apple Devices, Android file tools, or a card reader to move resources from a computer to a phone.

## Plain answer

Use a cable, Finder, Apple Devices, Android file tools, or a card reader to move resources from a computer to a phone.

## Field steps

1. Connect the phone - Use the correct cable and unlock the phone.
2. Trust the computer - Accept the trust prompt if the phone asks.
3. Choose a clear folder - Use Downloads, Files, Music, Videos, or a named VillageServer folder.
4. Copy a small test - Move one file first and confirm it opens.
5. Copy the folder - After the test works, copy the needed resource folder.

## Key points

Best use: Use this handout when this exact device route is in front of you.

First test: Move one small file before moving a whole folder.

Offline check: Confirm the received file opens without mobile data.

Teach-back: Ask the receiving person to repeat the transfer.
