Plain answer

Use AirDrop for nearby iPhones when both devices are unlocked and sharing is allowed.

Field steps

1. Turn on AirDrop - Open Control Center and allow AirDrop for contacts or everyone for a short time.
2. Choose the file - Open Files, Photos, or the app where the resource is stored.
3. Share with AirDrop - Tap Share, choose AirDrop, then pick the receiving iPhone.
4. Accept and save - On the receiving phone, accept the file and confirm where it opened.
5. Turn sharing back down - Return AirDrop settings to the safer normal setting after the transfer.

Key points

Best use: Use this handout when this exact device route is in front of you.

First test: Move one small file before moving a whole folder.

Offline check: Confirm the received file opens without mobile data.

Teach-back: Ask the receiving person to repeat the transfer.
