Plain answer

Use a microSD card and adapter when phones or computers need a simple offline storage path.

Field steps

1. Load the card - Put the resource folder on the microSD card from a trusted computer.
2. Use the adapter - Insert the card into the phone or card reader adapter.
3. Open Files - Use the phone file app to browse the card.
4. Copy what helps - Copy selected resources to the phone for offline access.
5. Label the card - Keep the card labeled so it returns to the correct kit.

Key points

Best use: Use this handout when this exact device route is in front of you.

First test: Move one small file before moving a whole folder.

Offline check: Confirm the received file opens without mobile data.

Teach-back: Ask the receiving person to repeat the transfer.
